The Meise Botanic Garden is located in the Flemish Brabant, north of Brussels. It is one of the world's largest botanical gardens with 92 hectares, 18,000 plant species, an Herbarium of around 4 million collection items, of which nearly 2 million have been digitized. The Garden is an active member of the Flemish Open Science Board (FOSB) and expert in Biodiversity Informatics, and an Observer of the EOSC Association.
