## The guiding principles






## What happens in the rest of the region?

- EOSC Denmark Coordination Forum
- The objective of the <u>EOSC Denmark Coordination Forum</u> is to collect, share and use knowledge about EOSC nationally in order to integrate the EOSC in the research infrastructure, services and other support initiatives build up and provided for research in Denmark. Its main priorities (top 3) are:
  - o Engaging stakeholders at national level into EOSC.
  - Offering a channel to connect the national stakeholders with the EOSC.
  - o Coordinating EOSC activities at national level.
- EOSC Steering Board: Ministry of Higher Education and Science
- Danish mandated organisation: DeiC
- Only member in the EOSC-A

- National structure for EOSC in Norway
- In Norway, the national structure for EOSC is in planning (website of the Research Council of Norway) in near future. The national structure will be aimed to mobilise Norwegian institutions with (national) research infrastructures to become member of EOSC AISBL and contribute to the implementation of EOSC. As per its main three priorities, the national structure will:
  - o Engage stakeholders at national level into EOSC
  - o Disseminate and promote EOSC at national level
  - Coordinate EOSC activities at national level
- EOSC Steering Board: Ministry of Education and Research
- Norwegian Mandated Organisation: Research Council of Norway
- 4 EOSC-A members

## What happens in the rest of the region?

- National Reference Group for EOSC:
- The National Reference Group for EOSC was established to support the Swedish Research Council in their role as the mandated organisation. Stakeholders engaged in the EOSC Association, including EOSC-A member organisations and universities represented through the Association of Swedish Higher Education Institutions (SUHF), are represented in the group. In order to support the national objective of transitioning to Open Access to research data the National Reference Group for EOSC is integrated into a larger reference group for Open Access and EOSC.
- EOSC Steering Board: Ministry of Education and Research Swedish Research Council
- Swedish mandated organisation: Swedish Research Council
- · 12 members in the EOSC-A

# First EOSC regional tripartite event in the Nordic & Baltic countries, 4 October 2022, Tallinn

- **85 participants from 7 countries** (Ministry representatives, ESFRI delegates, Vice rectors, RPOs Managers, Regional initiative reprs)
- Highlights
  - Need for strategic coordination multi-level cooperation in implementing EOSC and Open Science.
  - o Full commitment from the Nordic and Baltic countries toward EOSC and Open Science
  - RFOs and RPOs are the conduits to researchers for the EOSC uptake. EOSC is also an institutional responsibility
  - EOSC national structures are key to provide a network and communication channel for national stakeholders
