Why perform Monitoring?

- sharing of best practices: what works? Can it be applied in other countries and/or institutions?
- overview of actual investment
- demonstrate the commitment to / by EOSC providers
- monitor evolution
- motivate MS/AC and institutions to do better & more for the EOSC

How?

- through the <u>EOSC Observatory</u> for the EOSC-SB survey, to be filled by the EOSC-SB members
- through the EOSC-Association dedicated tool for the AAP
 (additional activities plan), to be filled by the EOSC-Association members (not observers)

What to monitor?

Policies

 national & institutional policies on various aspects of Open Science

Practices

- Action plans and investments Impact
- Resulting uptake of Open Science, increase in research productivity
- KPIs at institutional level

Keep in mind

- Avoid asking the same question in different surveys
- Pull information automatically rather then asking
- Share results and methodology openly
- We still need to align the various monitoring approaches (ERA, NPR, EOSC-SB, EOSC-A, Unesco, ...)
