


Open Science at the centre of European research policy




Open Science – EC's current fields of actuation

ERA ACTION 1

Enable the open sharing of knowledge and the re-use of research outputs, including through the development of the European Science Cloud (EOSC)

OUTCOMES

- Deploy Open Science Principles and identify Open Science best practices
- 2. Deploy the core components and services of EOSC and federate existing data infrastructures in Europe, working towards the interoperability of research data
- 3. Establish a monitoring mechanism to collect data and benchmark investments, policies, digital research outputs, open science skills and infrastructure capacities related to EOSC



ERA Action 1: Enable sharing of research knowledge, data and tools including through the EOSC

- A community-driven process (25 MS and several AC and other stakeholders are committed)
- **Gradual implementation** based on mutual alignment and pooling of resources at European, national and institutional levels

INFRAEOSC Destination in WP23-24

Continue to develop the EOSC in a more cohesive and structured manner so that it becomes a fully operational enabling ecosystem for the whole research data lifecycle.

Expected impacts:

- Increasing volumes of FAIR research data and other outputs




