COEOSC EuroScienceGateway

The EuroScience Gateway project provides access to distributed computing network across 13 European countries via user-friendly gateways.

It facilitates access to compute and storage infrastructures as well as to data, tools, workflows and services.

It offers the Galaxy framework across research domains



















EVERSE: European Virtual Institute for Research Software Excellence

The project is jointly led by CERTH and BSC. It builds upon the existing national competence centers on research software and expertise of the various scientific communities.

The project aims to create a framework for research software and code excellence, collaboratively designed and championed by the research communities in pursuit of building a European network of Research Software Quality and and setting the foundations of a future Virtual Institute for Research Software Excellence.

The project has already published the first version of the Research Software Quality tookit (RSQkit https://everse.software/RSQKit).

The ultimate ambition is to contribute towards a cultural change where research software is recognized as a primary element in the scientific process and the people that contribute to it are credited for their efforts.
