



- Datafication of biobanks & biomolecular resources with Biobanks operating as data centers



7,834 OMOP viables of clinical phenotype data with biochemical measurements, 10PB whole slide or radiology image data, OMICs data (> 200K genomes, proteomics, metabolomics etc.), National Registries connections with e.g. survival data and other data types incl. surveys, genealogy, patient-provided data.


