- 1.17 million researchers in Europe and 500k DS? Why don't we just make researchers be all paid as DSs? :-). How did you estimate that "need"?
- Shouldn't be somehow the presented educational resources connected to OER, open educational resources initiative. There were also Forster project.

- Disappointing that only 2 examples of training resource were picked from EU node - that's hardly (yet) a broad source of training resources.
- We try to move towards Open Science and FAIR through OERs, while these by themselves are rarely aligned with the same principles. How do we fix that challenge?
- Why haven't we been able to train enough DS and other crucial roles in data infrastructure? Is it a failure of training policies, approaches, or other factors?
- To what extent should publishers educate researchers about OS? Would publisher resources (e.g. an online educational hub) be much value to researchers?
- Why do we usually see the main focus of OS education on OA and research data when there are many other practices that should be addressed e.g. code, protocols etc
- The issue with OERs would be a lack of a common technical standard (like IMS CC or CP, or even SCORM) so these can be reused properly across organisations.
- What are your ideas on having a minimum set curriculum/baseline for OS, for different education levels? Right now, everyone is teaching something different.
- Will we ever be in a position to no longer need this discussion about "raising awareness" because it will be a done deal / normal?
- Follow-up to the previous question about difficulties in reusing materials. What are examples of the challenges?
- Successful training programs are often developed by structured communities: Carpentries, INOSC, etc. What about your own experiences?
