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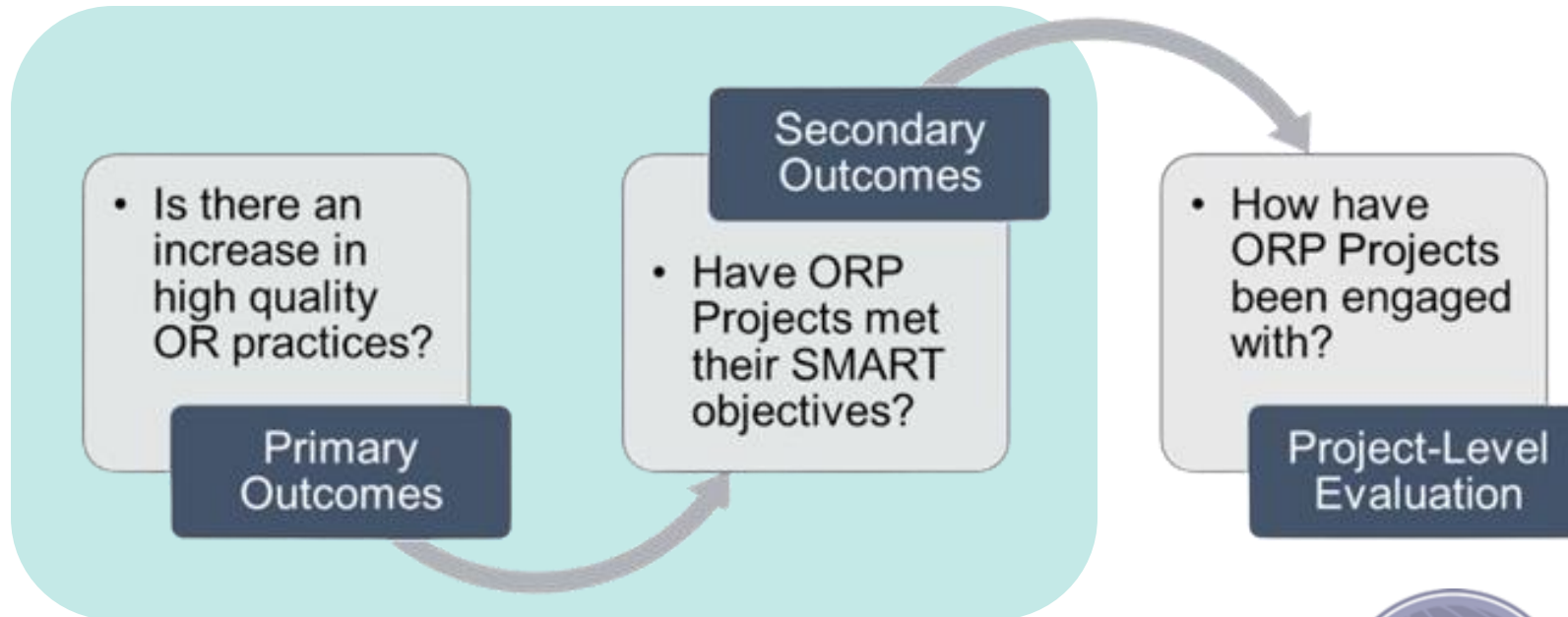
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The **aims** of the ORP evaluation are to:

- identify changes in OR practices at those institutions over time
- begin to identify where those changes might relate to activities of the ORP

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ORP Survey

The first ORP Survey was conducted in 2022-2023.

The ORP plans another survey in 2025 and one in 2027.

Aim: To provide evidence of the changes in prevalence of open research practices.

Key features:

- Aim for a representative sample using a stratified sampling approach
- Use language consistent with other surveys to enable comparisons
