

Preparatory grants under EOSC Gravity: €50k

- Preparatory work for potential future Nodes
- Deliverable: Project Charter



Enrolment call of EOSC Tripartite Governance

- No funding involved (all in-kind)
- Selection overseen by EOSC Tripartite

- Onboarding of resources to existing EOSC Nodes

EOSC Federation Enrolment Call



Purpose

Identification of a 2nd wave of Candidate EOSC Nodes to join the EOSC Federation Build-up phase.



Funding

No funding provided





- Submission of a **project charter** for the creation of a Node (national, multinational, thematic, or e-infrastructure) accompanied by a **written endorsement from corresponding authority/authorities**
- Agreement with existing Node(s) or other applicants to align on and propose the development of at least one scientific multi-Node use case or one use case realising a concrete contribution to federating capabilities
- Demonstration of capacity to function as a community gateway
- · Commitment of at least five individuals for the duration of the Build-up phase

Eligible applicants

- Not-for-profit or public-benefit organisation in EU member state or country associated with Horizon Europe
- Priority given to those countries/disciplines/e-infrastructures not yet present in the EOSC Federation





- Additional EOSC Nodes fully enrolled in the EOSC Federation covering additional geographical, thematic, or technical scope
- Increased engagement and added value for the scientific community
- Active contributions to shaping the operations of the EOSC Federation

coeosc Tripartite EOSC Federation Enrolment Call

→ What I gain in becoming an EOSC Federation Node

- Increase visibility and reach for research outputs
- Reduce fragmentation
- Improve collaboration and interoperability
- Support for Open Science and FAIR principles
- Access to broader resources and expertise
- Influence on policy and standardization
- Sustainability and economic benefits

→ Added value in using the EOSC Federation

- Visibility
- Access to new services
- Use EOSC AAI to interact with others

Preparatory Grants



Purpose

 6M projects to Support preparatory work for future EOSC Nodes → main output: Project Charter for future Node enrolment calls



Funding

• €800,000 total | up to €50,000/project



Eligible applicants

 Potential EOSC Candidate Nodes, EOSC-A Mandated Organisations, RPOs, other parties (organisations, networks, associations) from the wider RI landscape, e.g. organisations who want to become an EOSC Node, including from specific or thematic communities, excluding EOSC Gravity partners



Expected outcome

- A Project Charter that supports a future application to become an EOSC Node
- Alignment with EOSC Federation objectives & strong value proposition (scope, objectives, impact)
- Plan to meet minimum Node requirements (governance, technical readiness, community)
- Share training materials & lessons learned with the EOSC Academy











Inter-Project Grants



Purpose

- 6M projects to expand EOSC Federation services & show benefits for end users via:
 - Scientific use cases, or
 - Piloting onboarding of new services into EOSC Nodes



Funding

• €400,000 total (2nd call planned next year) | up to €50,000/project





- RIs, universities, RPOs, institutes, experts from the wider RI landscape, EOSC Candidate Nodes, organisations piloting service onboarding (excl. EOSC Gravity partners)
- Eligibility criteria: Include endorsement from at least one EOSC Node (via email confirmation)



Expected outcomes

- Deploy use case and/or pilot service onboarding
- Provide documentation, training, lessons learned EOSC Academy













Gravity



Applicants are allowed to submit proposals to EOSC Gravity parallel calls.

Nevertheless, multiple submissions by the same legal entity as a Project Coordinator are not allowed for the same call.


➤ There is an exception for large Research and Technology Organisations (RTOs) and Research-Performing Organisations (RPOs), in case several groups or research units from the same organisation wish to apply for the same call.

The maximum amount of funding that can be granted to a single organisation for all EOSC Gravity calls combined (3 calls in total: one preparatory call, and 2 inter-project calls) cannot exceed 100.000 EUR.



The maximum amount of funding that can be granted to a single organisation for the EOSC Gravity Inter-Project Calls (2 calls in total) cannot exceed 50.000 EUR.

Entity 1 applies and is selected for the Inter-Project Call

Funding = 50 k€

→ Limit of 50 k€
 reached for Inter-Project
 Entity 1 cannot apply for
 Inter-Project Call 2

Example 3

Preparatory Call

No application





Inter-project Call 1



Entity 1 applies as part of a consortium and request 20k€ in the budget breakdown + the project is selected for the Inter-Project Call

Funding = 20 k€

Entity 1 can apply for Inter-Project Call 2 OR for a SECOND APPLICATION for C1 as part of a Consortium and request up to 30 k€

Example 4

Preparatory Call



Entity 1 applies and is selected for the Preparatory Call

Funding = 50 k€

Inter-project Call 1

Funding = 0 k€

Inter-project Call 2



Entity 1 applies for the Inter-Project Call, as a consortium or alone

Funding = up to 50 k€

Multiple Submission and funding limit

2nd wave of Nodes

- → Multiple submissions are allowed for this call, if the same entity wants to apply to several types of Nodes.
- → There is no funding for this call.

Parallel application to Gravity Calls

Applicants can apply to the Inter-Project Call

A submitted application to the enrolment call would withdraw an application submitted by the same entity for the preparatory call










