Future portfolio of European Partnerships – state of play

Background note for the Partnership Knowledge Hub meeting

23 September 2026

The Commission proposal for Horizon Europe 2028–2034 calls for a more selective, strategic and coherent portfolio of European Partnerships.

An extensive consultation of Commission services and Member States/Associated Countries has been progressively consolidated into three alternative portfolio configurations reflecting different levels of aggregation and prioritisation.

This second consultation aims to evaluate the relative strengths and trade-offs of the emerging portfolio configuration and to support a comparative discussion of the portfolio as a whole. The configurations are not intended as fixed alternatives from which one should be selected; rather, the discussion will help identify the most promising elements and areas for further refinement, supporting convergence towards a coherent future portfolio.

The configurations remain work in progress and will continue to evolve in light of further input from Commission services and Member States/Associated Countries, as well as the results of the ongoing open public consultation.

The group's mission is to advise the Commission in the implementation of the strategic coordinating process for EU R&I partnerships, and to provide a forum for coordination and cooperation with Member States and related stakeholders, in line with Article 6(5) of the Specific Programme of Horizon Europe. The objective of the strategic coordinating process is to support a coherent, evidence-based and strategic policy making on R&I partnerships in Europe, guided by the criteria framework in the Annex III of the Horizon Europe Regulation. 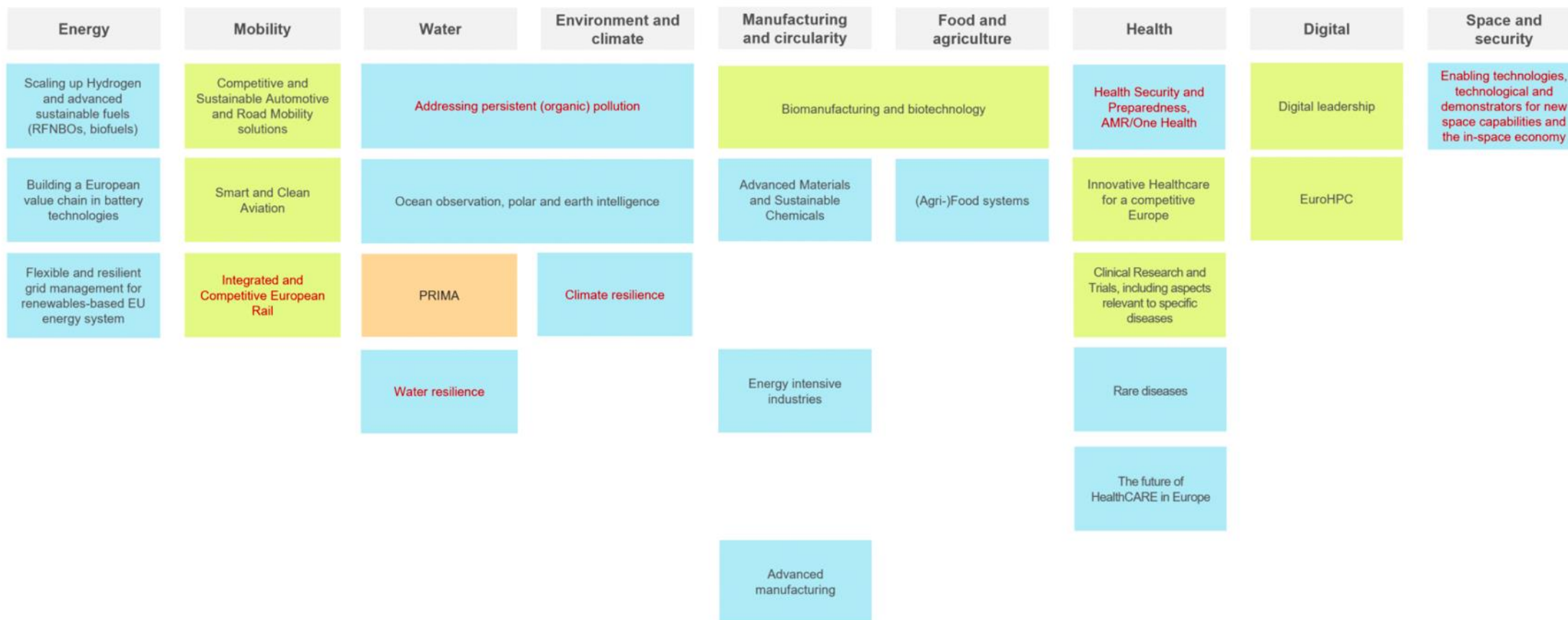

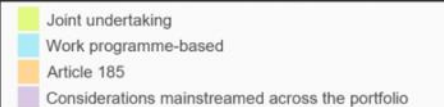

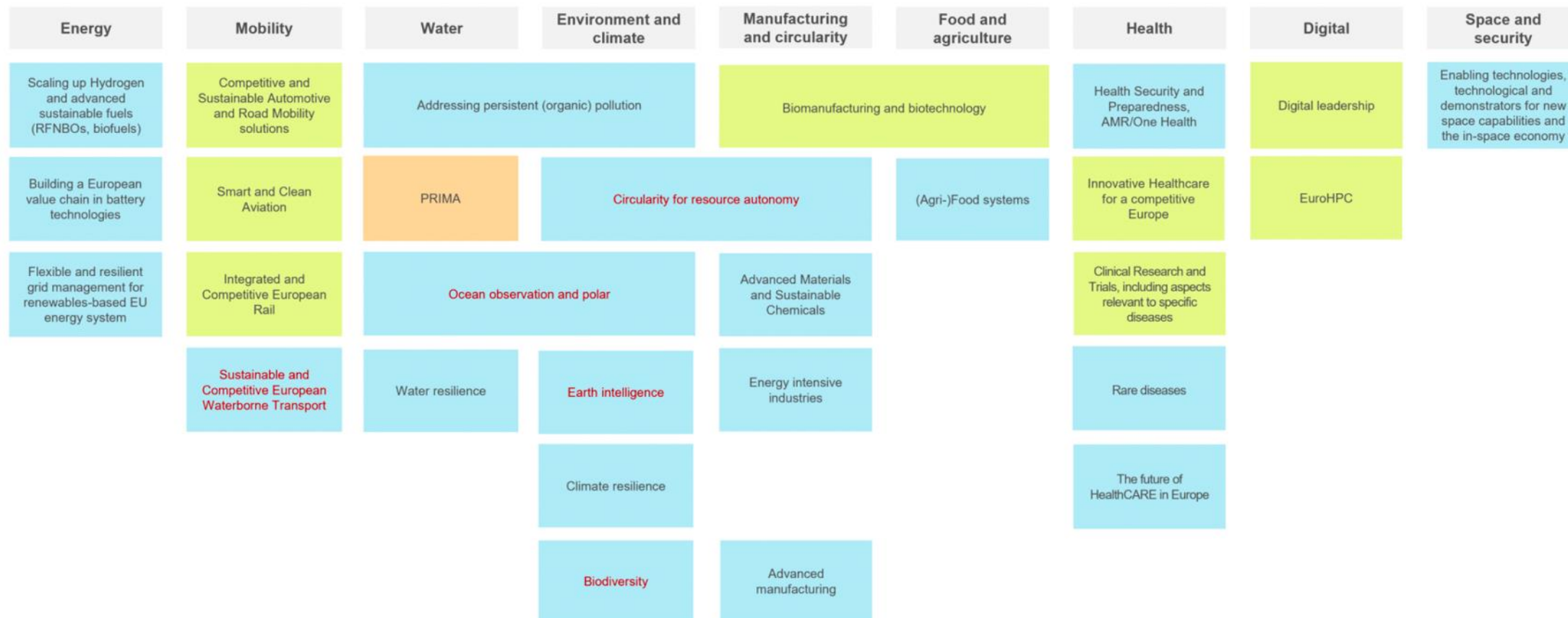

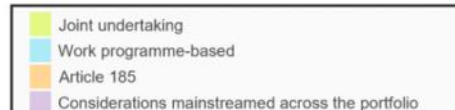

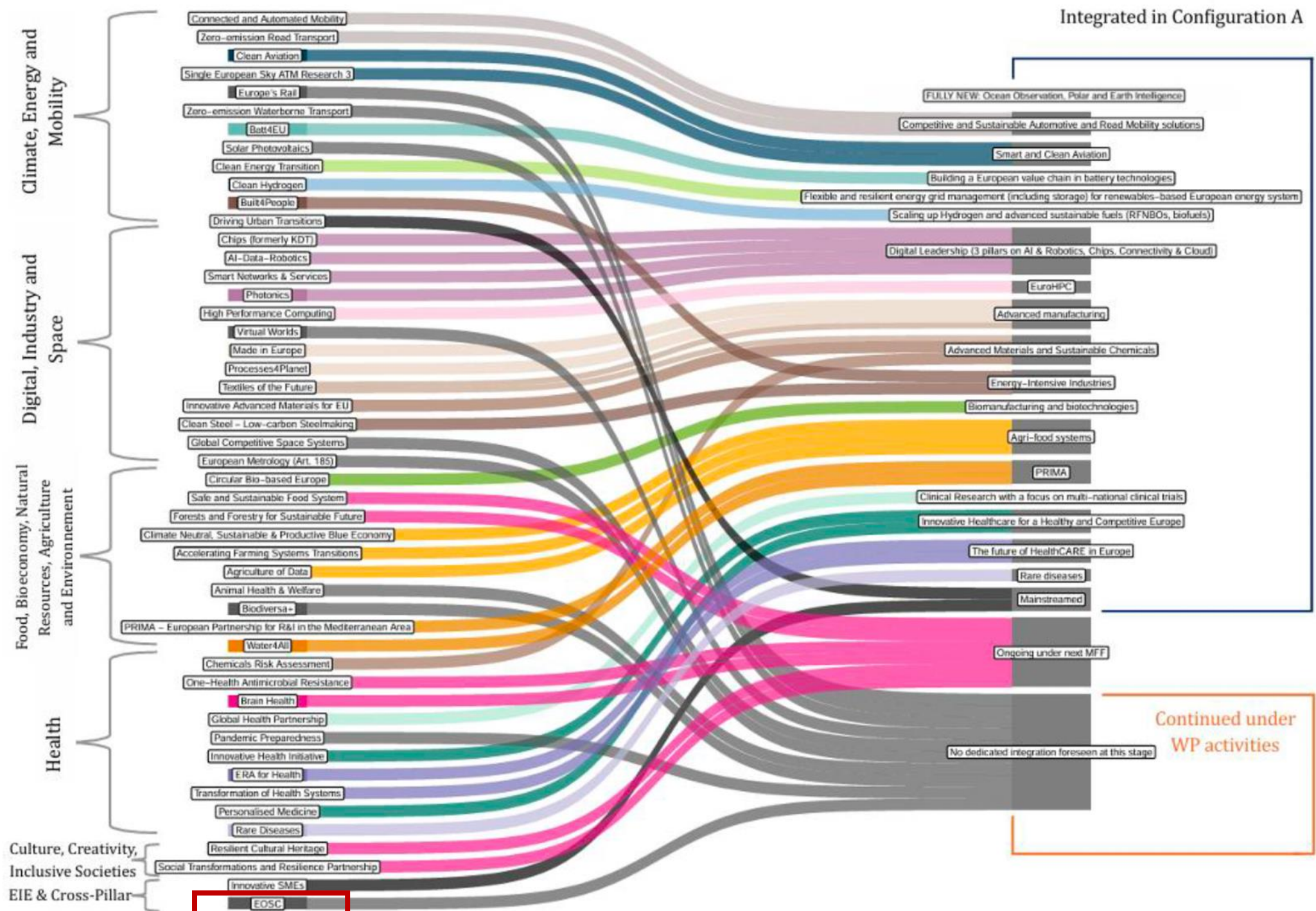

No Partnership Scenario for EOSC

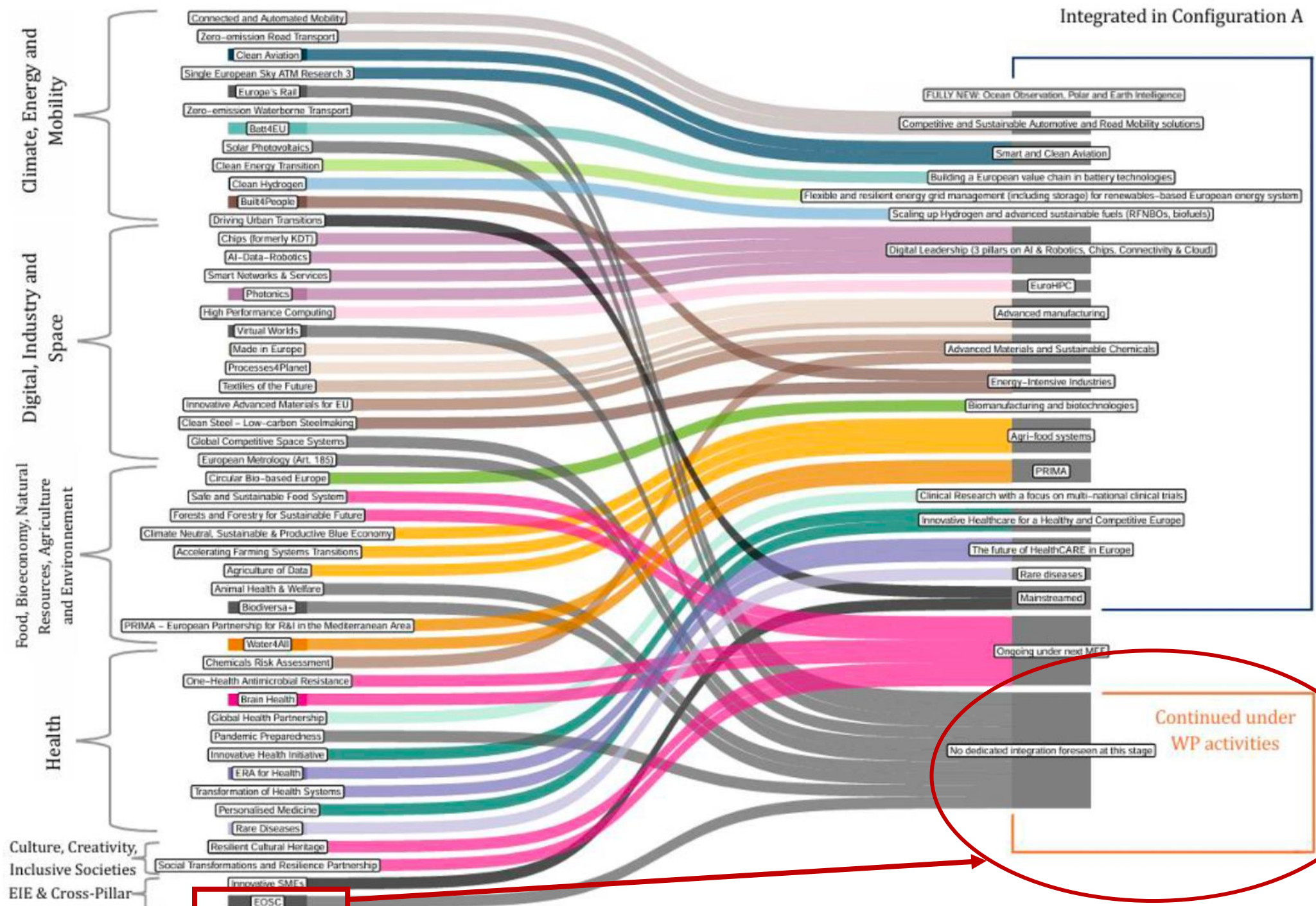

PKH Meeting, 23 September 2026

Many delegations (15/20 – tbc) spoke up and explicitly mentioned EOSC.

Some countries complained about the entire process the EC was applying.

The survey deadline has been extended from 18 to 25 September

European Research Area and Innovation Committee (ERAC)

The European Research Area and Innovation Committee is a high-level joint advisory committee on strategic policy, providing timely advice to the Council, the Commission and member states on strategic research and innovation (R&I) policy issues.

Composition and meetings

The members of ERAC are the member states and the Commission. Each member appoints up to two representatives with a high level of executive responsibility for R&I policies to the Committee.

Representatives of countries associated with the EU's R&I framework programmes may be invited to ERAC meetings for specific agenda items.

ERAC is co-chaired by a member state's representative and a Commission representative.

The General Secretariat of the Council provides secretariat services to the Committee.

Plenary meetings are usually held twice a year, but extraordinary meetings may also be convened, which is a frequent practice.

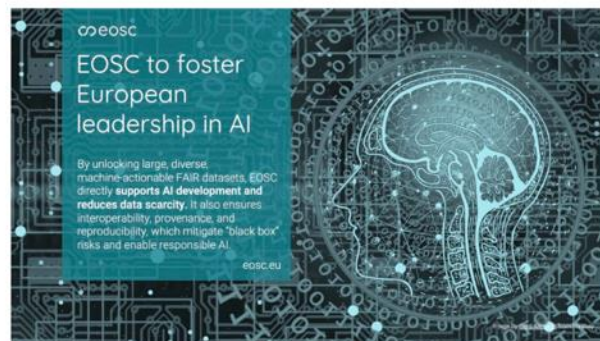

As the Partnership Knowledge Hub meets today to discuss the future of the FP10 Partnerships, we want to be clear: the Metrology Partnership must continue under FP10.

Metrology is not a scientific niche activity, it is horizontal infrastructure. Reliable measurement underpins health, industry, energy, digital and defence alike.

We are concerned by a broader tendency in the Commission's thinking: a push to simplify FP10 by simply reducing the number of Partnerships and reorganising the rest along sectoral lines. Simplification is welcome. Crude reduction is not. Cutting horizontal partnerships weakens all sectors.

We call on the Commission to present a well founded, reasoned proposal for the Partnerships under FP10. A Partnership portfolio without an Article 185 TFEU Partnership on Metrology will not be accepted by the Parliament.

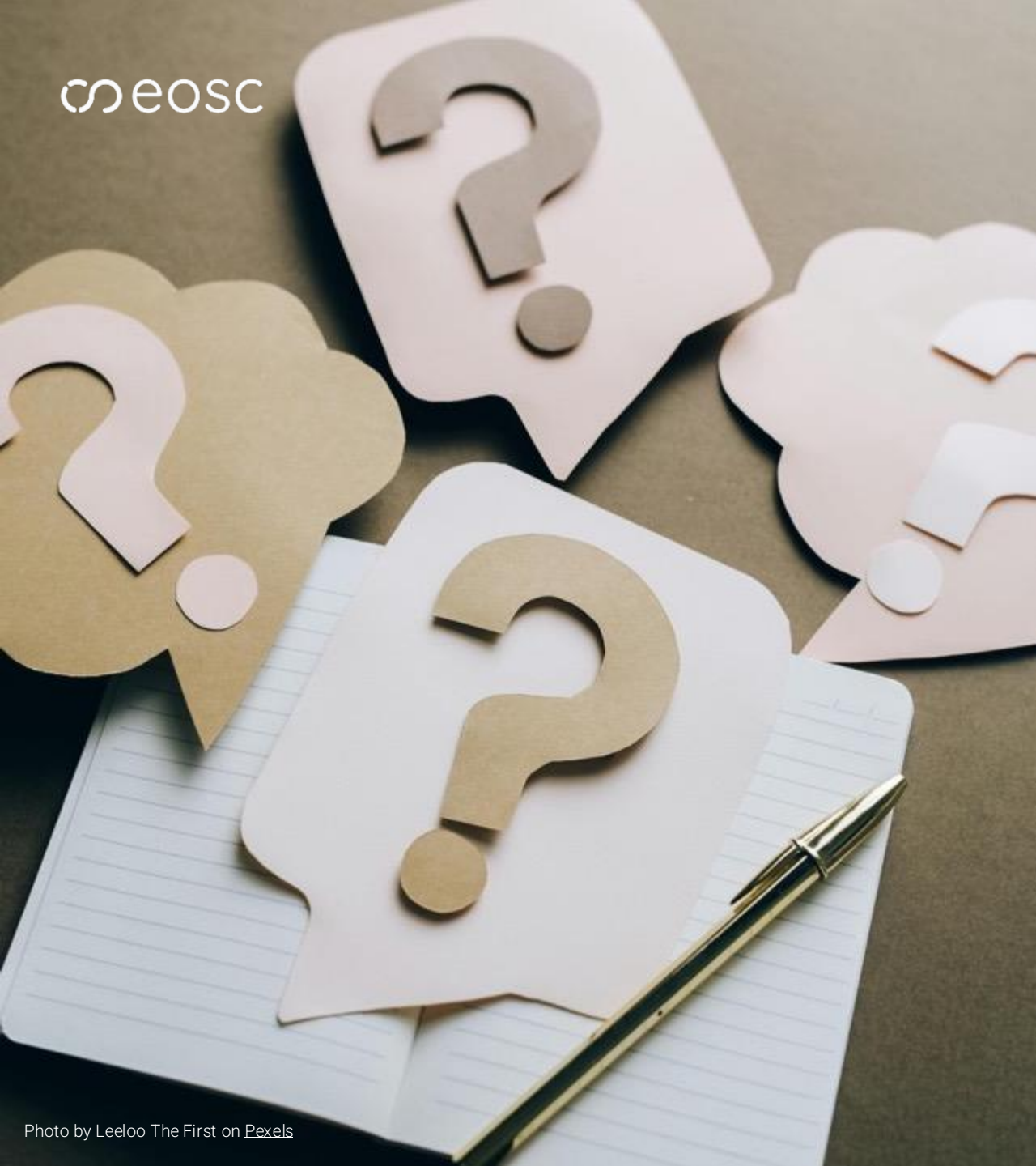

Important to turn this around **urgently**

Subject: Urgent attention requested: EOSC's omission from the Commission's "Future portfolio of European Partnerships – state of play; Background note for the Partnership Knowledge Hub meeting"

Dear Minister [Name],

We write on behalf of the undersigned [country] members and observers of the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) Association to bring to your attention ongoing developments that, without intervention, risk inflicting long-term damage to the [future of research and innovation in Europe](#), in particular with respect to the Union's AI posture and future security and sovereignty of Europe's critical research data and infrastructures.

As organisations representing [country's] research community, we have made substantial commitments to the European Open Science Cloud. [INSERT COUNTRY-SPECIFIC CONTRIBUTIONS, INCLUDING NATIONAL AND ORGANISATIONAL INVESTMENTS, EOSC NODE DEVELOPMENT AND RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURES.] We are therefore deeply concerned by the proposal currently in circulation, "Future portfolio of European Partnerships – state of play; Background note for the Partnership Knowledge Hub meeting", which makes no dedicated provision for EOSC.

Following sustained European, national and community co-investment, the EOSC Federation is set to enter its operational phase in mid-October at the [EOSC Symposium 2026](#) in Florence. This will set in motion a growth phase [expanding the capabilities and resources](#) of EOSC Nodes distributed [across Europe](#).

In her 16 September State of the Union Address, President von der Leyen emphasised the fundamental importance of Europe's high-quality data, describing them as "a precious European treasure". EOSC is being built precisely to enable trusted access to Europe's distributed research data, supporting scientific excellence, European sovereignty and the development of AI-enabled research services.

Through two framework programmes, including the current EOSC Partnership, the Commission has led [Member States](#) and thousands of individuals in the [European research community](#) along the path to building EOSC. The possibility of withdrawing dedicated support at this stage raises serious questions about the continuity of European commitments and the return on public investment, including our own national and organisational contributions.

EOSC may be Europe's best and last chance to create a safe space in which to govern its critical research data. We therefore respectfully request two actions:

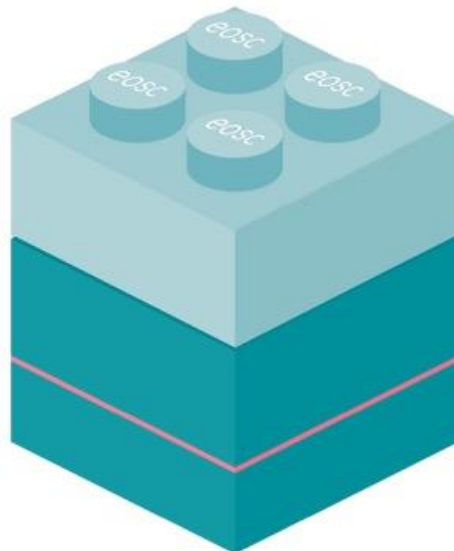

[DATELINE]—As the EOSC Federation moves into operations this October, [COUNTRY] is contributing [NATIONAL NODE / INFRASTRUCTURE / SERVICES / INVESTMENT] to a new European research environment that leverages the European Union's treasure trove of high-quality data for stronger science, innovation and AI.

Europe has reached an important milestone in the way researchers access and use data. In October 2026, at the [European Open Science Cloud \(EOSC\) Symposium](#) in Florence, Italy, the EOSC Federation will formally move into operations, connecting research data, services and infrastructures across countries, institutions and disciplines. [Twenty-eight](#) national, thematic and infrastructure EOSC Nodes—supported by 218 European research organisations—are currently working toward production, with dozens more preparing to join in the coming years.

The science already shows what this can mean. EOSC Federation [use cases](#) include combining genomic, environmental and modelling data to understand how marine microorganisms contribute to [carbon sequestration](#); enabling cross-border analysis of pathogen genomes for [outbreak detection](#) and [antimicrobial-resistance surveillance](#); training AI models to improve [prostate-cancer screening](#); and allowing researchers to [discover data](#) within, and to [run computational workflows](#) close to, the [enormous datasets](#) produced by Europe's large-scale research infrastructures like [CERN](#).

For [COUNTRY], a production-grade EOSC Federation is both a European achievement and a national one.

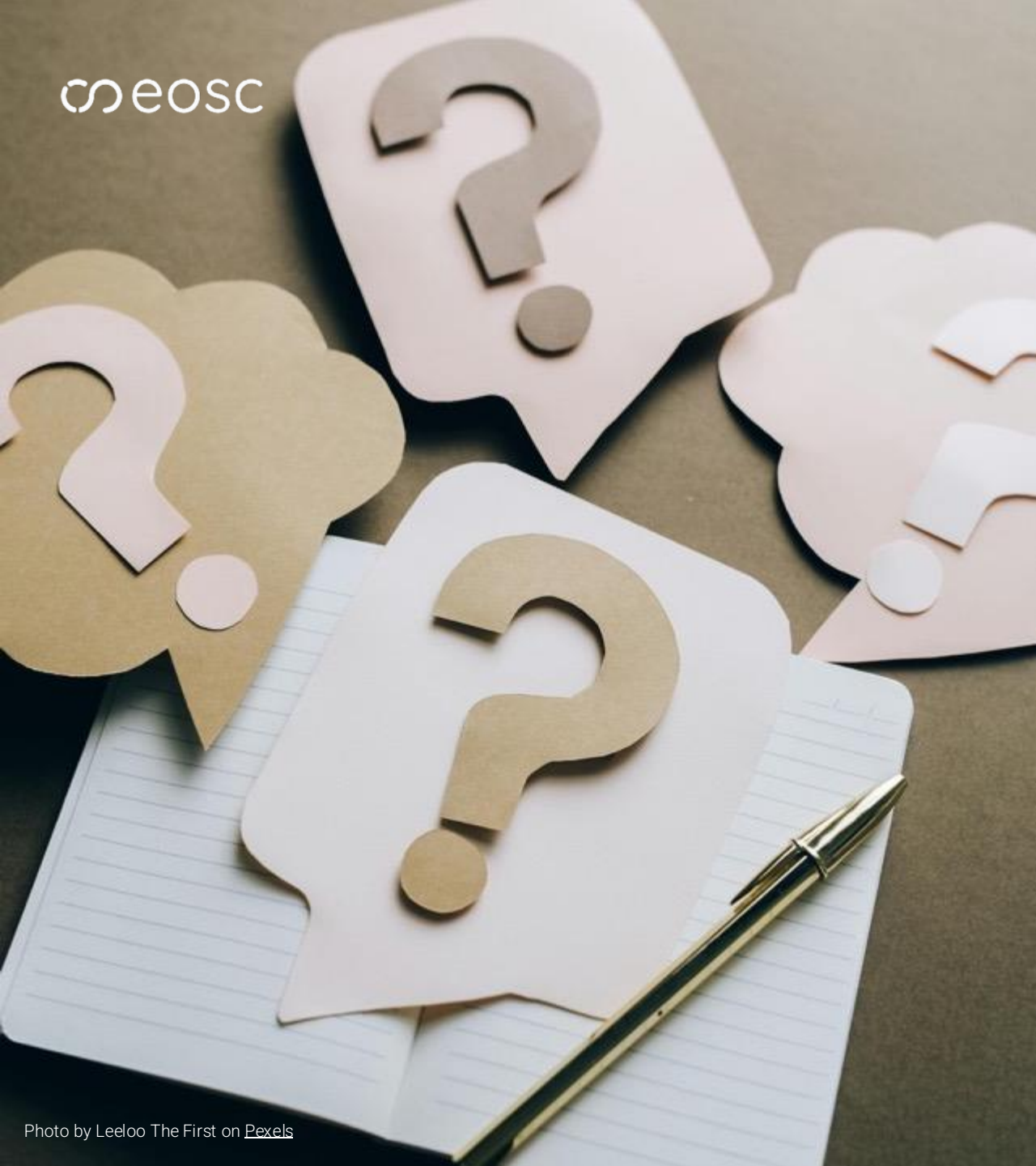
